

The final sale of the 2015 winter season took place in Port Elizabeth today, with a smaller offering of 89 974 kg's.

The quality of the offering can not be compared with the previous sale, with the market experiencing a small correction to close 3% lower on R217.89 per kg and a 100% sales clearance.

Overall the winter season delivered excellent results, with the closing winter sale up 18% from the opening sale of the winter season and 16% higher than the corresponding sale of the 2014 season. The average market indicator for the 2015 winter season was also 10% higher than 2014 at R197.68 p/kg.

A highest price of R345.00 p/kg was paid for a bale 27 micron super style kid mohair.

Although volumes offered on the auction floor was slightly down from 2014, it is expected that production will show a minimal increase for the year.

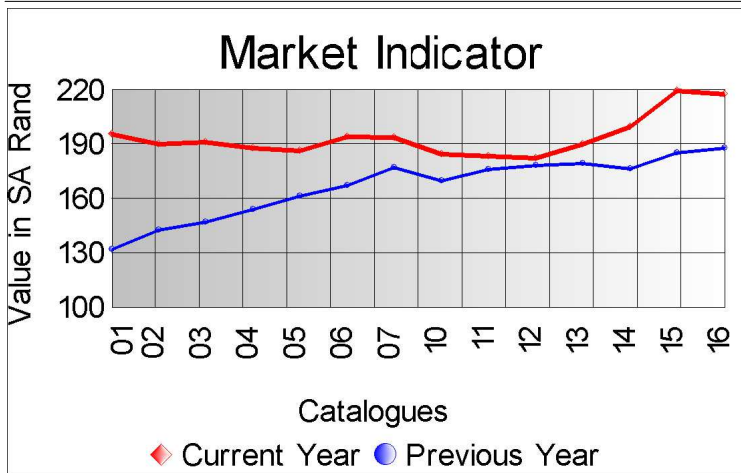

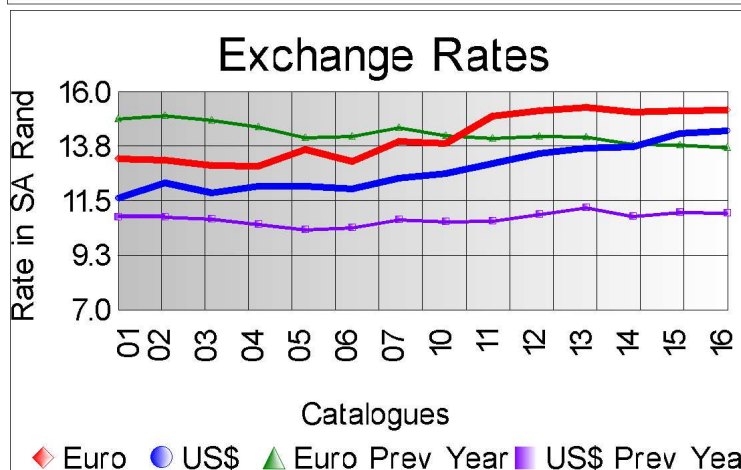
