

The last sale of the 2016 mohair season took place in Port Elizabeth today, with 86 886kg's on offer.

The quality of the offering was not comparable with the previous sale, which had a negative effect on prices, with the stronger SA currency also resulting in difficult trading conditions, especially for the greasy exporters.

The average market indicator eased by 1.8% to close on R185.00 per kg, with an overall sales clearance of 84%. A number of lots were passed by the brokers for intake into the pool scheme, which contributed to the lower sales clearance.

A highest price of R335.00 per kg was paid for a bale of good style 25 micron mohair.

The average market indicator for the 2016 winter season closed down from the 2015 season on R186.69 per kg, but the average indicator for the year was substantially higher at R217.39 per kg.

Although the quantity offered via the official auction sales were up from 2015, it is anticipated that production volumes will remain fairly unchanged in 2016.

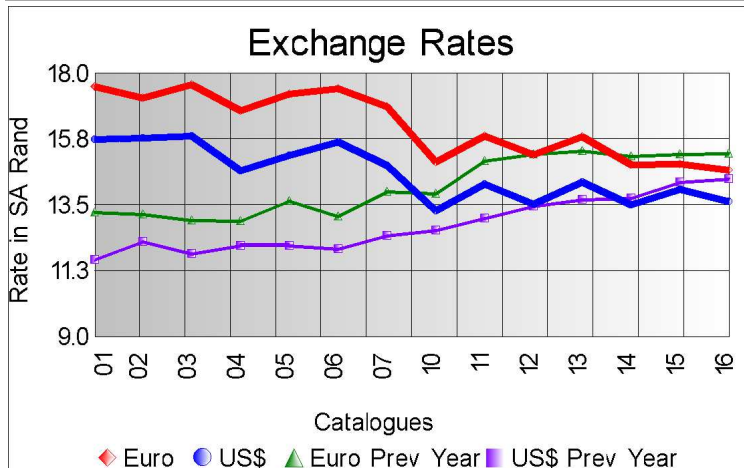
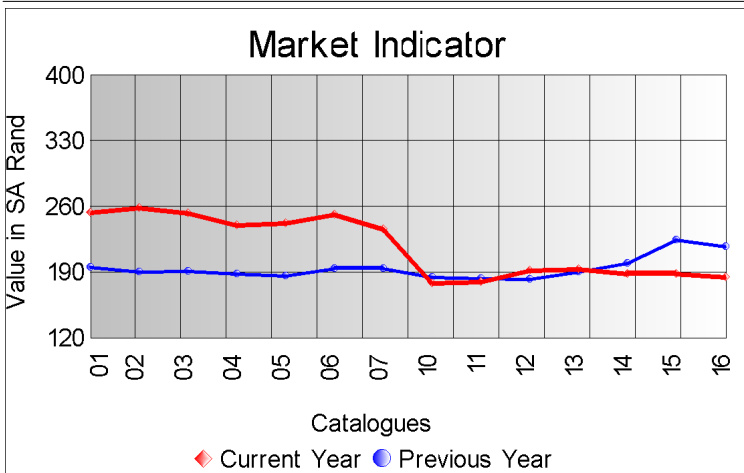
