

The final sale of the 2020 season took place in Port Elizabeth today, 10 December 2020, with 85786.30 kg on offer of which 91% was sold.

The average market indicator increased by 3% (increased by 5% in dollar terms), from the previous sale, to close on R252.34 per kg.

The offering consisted of some good individual clips. The buying houses competed actively for the last mohair available for the year. RMS-certified mohair was once again the most sought after mohair on the day.

A highest price of R583.00 per kg was paid for a bale of good style 24 micron kid mohair. The average market indicator over the winter season came in at R239.75 per kg, which is 6% higher than the first sale of the winter season, and 7% higher than the 2019 winter season.

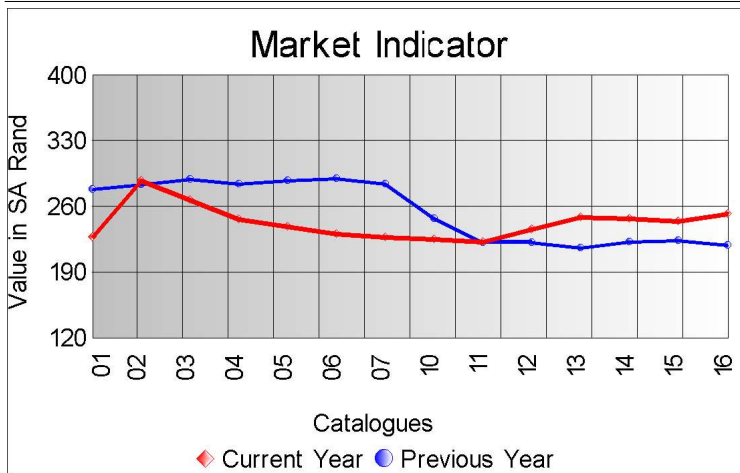

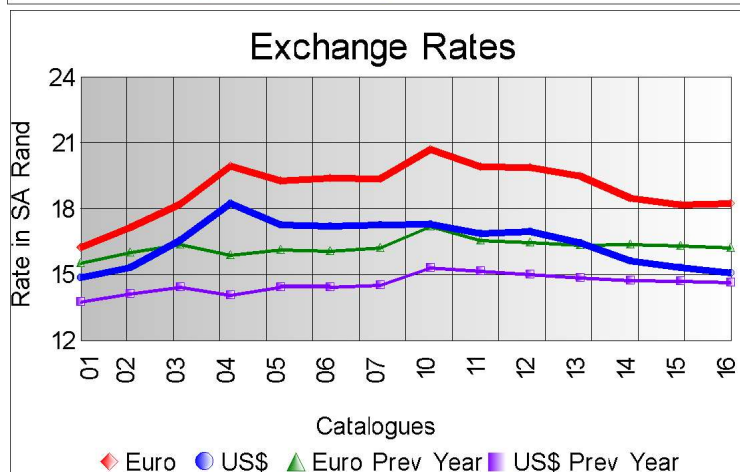
