

The fifth sale of the 2011 winter season took place in Port Elizabeth today (1 November 2011) with a small offering of 77 563 kg's.

The offering consisted of more shorter and seedy hair than the previous sale, which should be taken into consideration when comparing prices. Although the weaker currency did offer some support to the market, there was once again a lack of strong competition amongst all the buying houses.

The slow demand from China is still playing a negative role in the market place. There was very good demand for fine winter kids on today's sale, with the weaker demand for the stronger kids driving the market indicator for kids down. A highest price of R230.00 p/kg was paid for a bale of 26 micron good style winter kid mohair and an overall sales clearance of 97% was achieved, with the average market indicator closing on R87.33

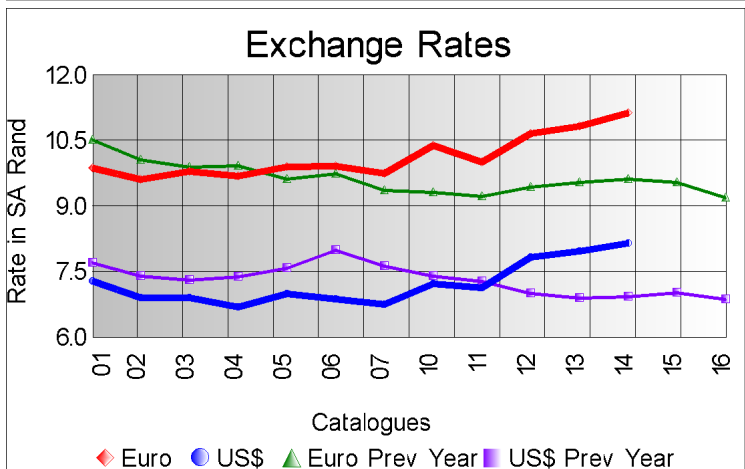
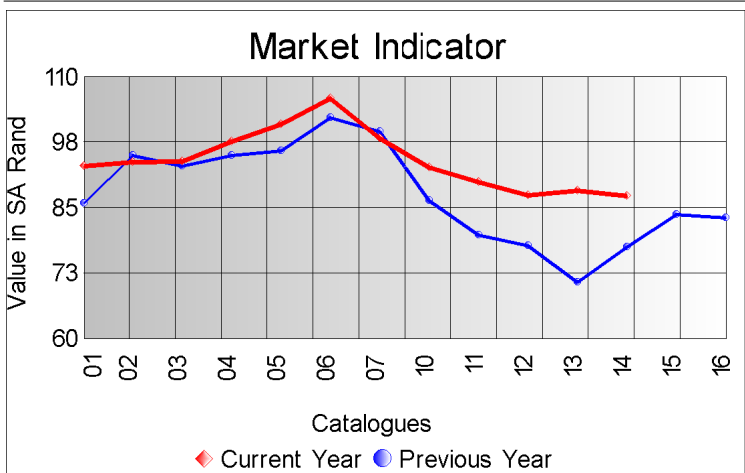
