The third sale of the 2014 summer season took place in Port Elizab eth today (25 March 2014), with 98% of the offering being sold.

The market continued to deliver strong results, with the market in dicator gaining a further 3% to close on R147.43 per kg. This is 11.6% higher than the opening sale of the season and 31% higher from the corresponding sale of 2013.

The offering consisted of very good quality mohair with excellent style and character. The buyers had to compete strongly for the mohair on offer, driving the prices higher.

A highest price of R530.00 per kg was paid for a bale of 24 micron good style kid mohair.

Compared to the previous sale prices were as follows:


