

The third sale of the 2022 winter season took place in Port Elizabeth today, with 163 684 kg's on offer of which 42% was sold.

The offering was made up of good quality mohair, with 80% of the mohair being RMS certified. With a recent slump in demand for mohair and buying houses sitting on some mohair stock, the buying houses were relatively passive on today's sale. The high inflation rates in Europe and the United Kingdom, as well as China's slow economic growth, have a direct impact on our international mohair buyers.

More than half of the mohair on offer at today's sale remains unsold, as buyer offers fell short of grower reserves. As a result, comparing the results of this sale to the previous sale is difficult; therefore, we will not quote the results of today's sale.

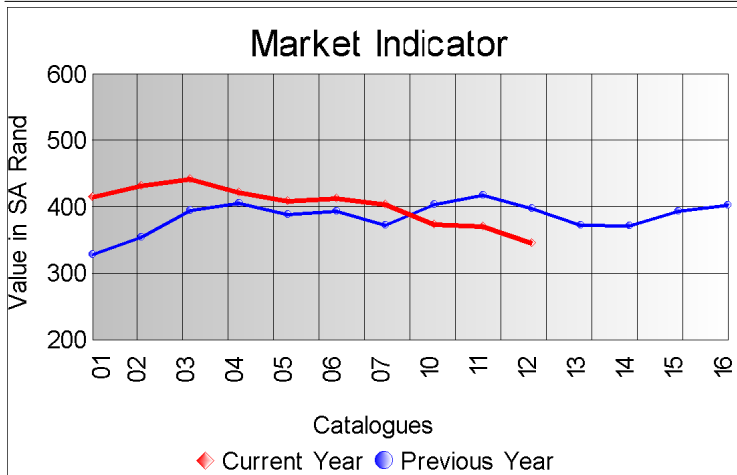
A highest price of R760.10 p/kg was paid for a bale of 26 micron good style kid mohair.

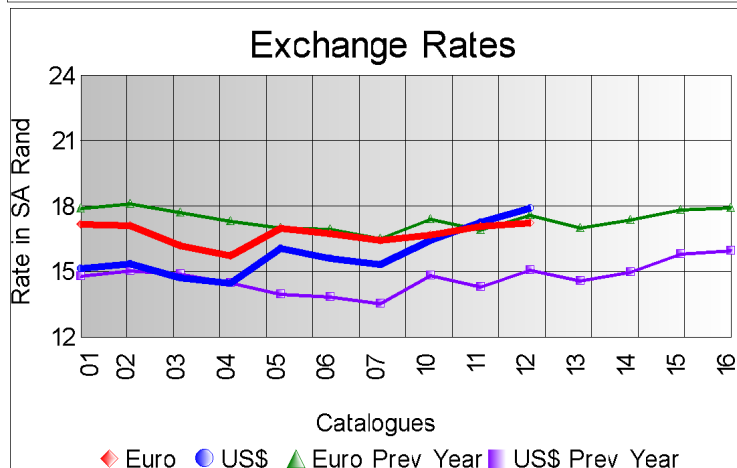
