

The final sale of the 2021 season took place in Port Elizabeth today, 7 December 2021, with 82 121 kg on offer of which 99% was sold.

The offering consisted of some good individual clips. The buying houses competed actively for the last mohair available for the year. RMS-certified mohair was once again the most sought after mohair on the day.

The average market indicator increased by 2% (1% in dollar-terms) from the previous sale, to close on R403.17 p/kg.

A highest price of R750 p/kg was paid for a bale 24 micron super style kid mohair.

The average market indicator over the entire winter season came in at R395.07 which is 65% higher than the 2020 winter season.

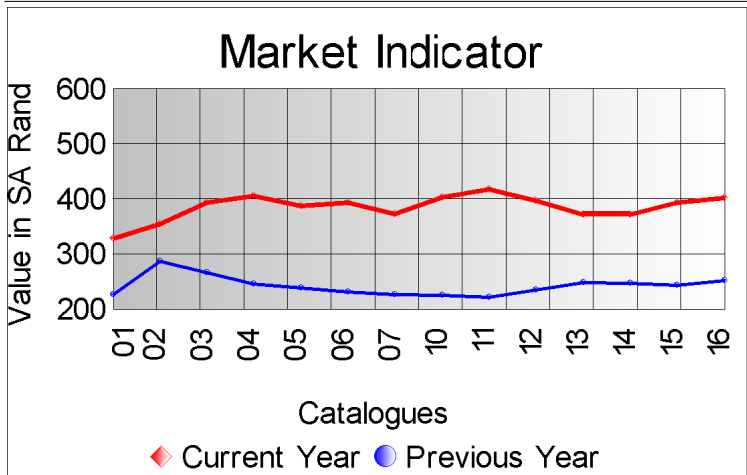

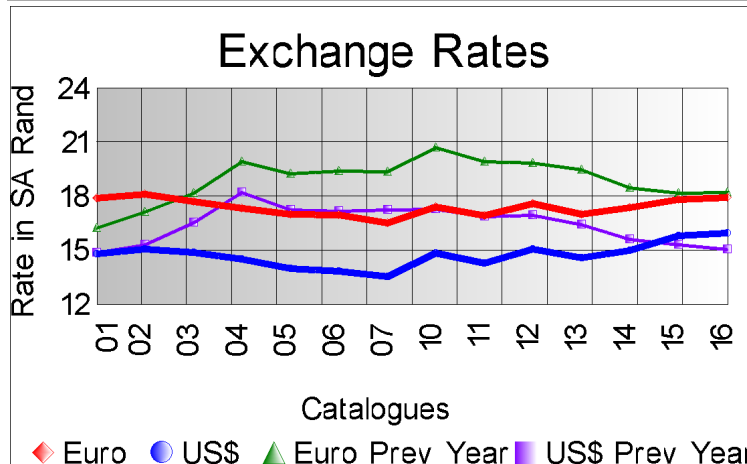
